

## MODERN DISPOSAL SERVICES, Inc. INFORMATION

The Town of Pendleton's trash and recycling collection services are provided by Modern Disposal Services, Inc. The information provided should be kept for future reference.

**HOLIDAYS:** Solid waste services are provided in your neighborhood on the same day each week unless altered due to a holiday **falling on or before** your collection day within the week. If one of these holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day **and only these** holidays falls on or before your collection day, collection will be one (1) day late! Recycling services are provided on the same day as your solid waste collection, but on an every other week schedule.

**ACCEPTABLE WASTE:** All acceptable waste must be in watertight cans with filled lids and lifting handles, or in 30 gallon watertight bags or in a 95 gallon wheeled cart. The limit each week is the equivalent of six (6) 30 gallon bags or cans, plus one acceptable large item and unlimited, properly packed and acceptable recyclables. Please call the customer service department at 800-330-7107 to schedule collection of a large item that contains Freon.

For the protection of the collection team, the weight of these items must be less than 50 pounds each. All acceptable waste and recyclables **must be placed at the street's edge for collection by 6:00 am** on your collection day **and not before 6:00 pm** on the day prior to your collection day. **Empty containers must be removed from the street's edge by no later than 6:00 pm on your collection day.**

Carpet must be cut into sections no longer than four (4) feet and must be rolled and securely tied. Town crews conduct brush pick-up. Collection frequency will depend on seasonal volumes. Place brush with butt ends facing street's edge. Maximum diameter of brush is limited to four (4) inches in diameter and twelve (12) feet in length. The size of the brush pile should not exceed three (3) feet high.

**UNACCEPTABLE WASTE:** Dead animals; explosive and flammable materials; pesticides; batteries; compressed gas cylinders; motor oils; regulated and non-regulated hazardous, pathological, medical, infectious, construction, remodeling, demolition and septic waste, sludge; junk automobiles and recreational vehicles (ATV's); and tires. For information on the disposal of household hazardous waste, such as oil, lead-based paint, automobile antifreeze, solvents, pesticides, batteries, etc. please contact the Niagara County Refuse Disposal District at 434-6568. Waste motor oils can be disposed of at most local services stations or automotive repair centers.

Town residents using needles to administer medication in their homes may dispose of these items by breaking them, then placing them in a rigid plastic container with a screw type lid, placing the lid on securely, taping the lid on and then placing the container in their regular trash.

Aerosol cans are not recyclable and should be placed in your regular trash. Empty paint cans, which contained latex-based paint, are acceptable waste. Lids must be removed and contents completely removed and dried. Place in your regular trash. Animal feces are acceptable in small quantities. Please contain securely for the protection of the collection crews and place in trash.
