## TOWN OF PENDLETON Work Session May 27, 2014

A work session of the Town Board of the Town of Pendleton was held at the Town Hall, 6570 Campbell Blvd., Pendleton, N.Y. on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of May 2014 at 7:00 P.M. Town Board Discussions:

Salt Sheds

The Board and Highway Superintendent Stowell discussed various types of salt sheds and the pros and cons of each. Ideally, but the most costly choice would be a wooden structure with an estimate of the life expectancy of 20 to 25 years. Superintendent Stowell mentioned other types of sheds and pointed out what other municipalities have been using. He gave the Board very rough estimates for the cost but will provide a detailed estimate along with life expectancies of the various types of sheds.
