

## **Town of Pendleton 2011 Summer Recreation Registration Information**

Registration for the Town of Pendleton's 2011 Summer Recreation will be held at the Pendleton Hall 6570 Campbell Boulevard, **Saturday, June 18 from 9 am to noon.**

**Please Note:** That due to the recently revised NYS Sanitary Code, the Town of Pendleton's Recreation Program has been classified a Children's Camp. In order to comply with the new codes, **Parents/Guardians will need to submit a copy of each child's immunization record when registering.** Parents/Guardians are encouraged to pick up (from the town hall), or download from the town's website, both the **2011 Registration Form and Individual Health Record and Medical Permit Form** prior to registration.

**Please have the completed forms and immunization records ready to turn in at registration.**

**Also new this year: Parents/Guardians are required to accompany their children to and from the Starpoint Middle School Cafeteria and sign them in and out. All children will report to the school cafeteria, even those just attending the swim program.** At each child's assigned time, Recreation Staff will accompany children in the swim program, from the cafeteria to the pool and then back to the cafeteria.

**Note: Those attending the swim program should be signed in at the Middle School Cafeteria, a minimum of 15 minutes prior to the start of their assigned swim time.**

This year's program will run from Monday, June 27, 2011 to Thursday, August 4, 2011. **Monday, June 27 is for staff training and those needing swim evaluations. There will be no other recreation or swim activities on this day.** Wednesday's, July 6, 13, 20 and 27 are reserved for field trips only. **There will be no other recreation or swim activities on these days. There is no Summer Recreation or Swim Program on July 4.**

Registration is open to children between the ages of 5 – 15 yrs. The Summer Recreation & Swim programs are free for town residents. **There is a \$5.00 non-refundable per child fee, for each field trip a child registers for.** Proof of residency (driver's license or tax/utility bill) is required. The program is available to non-residents, who live within the Starpoint Central School District. Non residents will be charged a registration fee of \$150. Nonresident participation is limited to the activities located at Starpoint Central School. Participants may sign up for a single activity (ex. Swimming or field trips) or any combination of activities (ex. Swimming & summer rec.). **Information regarding field trips will be available at signup.**

**Note: daily attendance is not required. You may attend one hour, one day, or whatever fits your schedule.**
