In order to progress the above referenced project with Federal Aid, the New York State Department of Transportation (NYSDOT) will need both a Resolution and a Supplemental Agreement, signed by the Town of Pendleton, indicating a commitment to continue to participate in the administration and funding of the various phases of this project.

Please obtain a Resolution authorizing the Town Supervisor to enter into the enclosed Supplemental Agreement #2 (SA #2) to Federal Aid Project Agreement No. D034821 with the NYSDOT to provide a total of \$800,000. This amount is both the Federal and Non-Federal share of the additional cost for the above project's Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) and Construction/Construction Inspection phases. SA #2 supersedes supplemental agreement No. 1 by increasing funding for Preliminary Engineering (Design I-VI) phase, removing the ROW Incidentals phase and adding the Construction/Construction Inspection phase.
