- 2. Baseball Contract is signed.
- 3. Tennis Courts- 3 bids are needed to pave and paint the basketball and tennis courts. We will make some calls to get information.
- 4. Summer Recreation- Rent is being imposed this year by Starpoint. Starpoint says it costs them \$4,500 a season to have the program there. The town board approved the payment to Starpoint. The recreation committee discussed an additional fee for people who are nonresidents of the town and school district. It will be \$100 more (\$325 for the season, swim will be \$35, and field trips will be \$20) Collection of staffing applications, Health Department paperwork, field trip planning, and getting ready for sign ups are currently in process.
- 5. Soccer- Ed Harman scheduled the fields. Nets have been ordered.
- 6. Basketball- Mark Ruppert will look into the price of basketball poles and backboards. We will look into moving the existing basketball hoops and adding two more.
- 7. Kayak launch- Todd Ostrowski contacted Canal Corp and two suggestions based on elevation were East Canal near Dunnigan and East Canal near Mapleton.
- 8. There is a large rock near Depeau park. The hope is to move it to a better location. As the bike path is expanding, we are hoping we can have the rock moved to an entrance of the bike path.
