1. Ribbon Cutting- September 27 there was a ribbon cutting ceremony to celebrate the opening of the canal trail near Uncle G's at the Heritage Museum.
2. Kayak Launch- Chris Frey has been working on quotes and funding for a floating kayak launch off of the canal.
3. Pavilion at Depeau Park- Love of Skin put deposit down and construction is to begin in October for the shelter. Lion's Club and the Town Board chose a builder.
4. Summer Recreation- We discussed a small increase in pricing to offset the minimum wage increases. We would like to propose a price of \$250 for non-residents and \$55 for residents keeping the swim and field trip costs the same at \$25 and \$10 respectively. We discussed challenges regarding staffing for the program.
5. Ideas for Depeau Park- we hope to resurface the tennis courts and the roller hockey court. The pavilion is a work in progress. We are securing quotes.
6. We have been looking into possible grants to continue to improve our parks.
