§ 131-4 Communication towers fees.

[Added 6-3-1997]

- The fee for the construction and equipping of a tower shall be 1% of the cost of construction and equipping of the tower as estimated by the developer and verified by the town; or the minimum fee shall be \$1,000 \$2,000 and the maximum fee shall be **\$4,000. \$5,000**
- Each construction, modification or alteration of a tower shall require a permit and the fee as stated above.

§ 131-5 Stormwater management fees. [Added 2-2-2010]

A. Fees for land development activities. Any applicant submitting a SWPPP to the Town for a land development activity or land disturbance requiring a NYSDEC SPDES construction permit shall submit a fee to the Town based upon the acreage of the entire development in accordance with the following schedule:
