

At the regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Pendleton, Niagara County, New York, held in the Board Room at the Town of Pendleton Town Hall, 6570 Campbell Boulevard, Lockport, New York, 14094 at 7:00 p.m. on July 13, 2020.

WHEREAS, the Town of Pendleton has established and maintains a multiuse trail system that traverses the Town from the southeast trailhead on Townline Road to the northeast terminus on Lockport Road, and

WHEREAS, construction of the Town's trail system has been substantially funded by governmental grant programs dedicated to the establishment of such trail systems, and

WHEREAS, the section of trail from Meyer Road to Killian Road remains unimproved and it is in the best interest of all current and future trail users to commence construction activities to improve this section of trail, as has been completed on all other trail sections, and

WHEREAS, the Town Board desires to identify and pursue all possible funding opportunities to improve the section of trail between Meyer Road and Killian Road, and

NOW, **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Town Board of the Town of Pendleton on this 13th day of July 2020 that the Town Board is committed to completion of the Town's multiuse trail system and the Town's grant writing and management consultant is hereby directed to commence work on grant applications from any source that may provide full or partial funding for this project.
