What is Scouting For Food?

Scouting For Food is a nationwide ongoing program of the Boy Scouts of America rooted in very foundation of the Scouting movement at its slogan “Do A Good Turn Daily”. Done locally by Cub Scout Packs and Scouts BSA Troops either in the Spring or prior to the winter holidays, the program supports local food pantries supported by the Scout units.

In the past, Scouts have distributed door tags on a Saturday, returning a week later to pick up donations. Due to the Covid-19 Pandemic, we’ve adopted a “drive-in” model to more effectively protect residents and Scouts and to ensure that anyone who wishes to donate is not missed.

Residents are urged to bring donations of non-perishable food items like pasta, canned goods, sauces, vegetables, canned fruit, etc. to supplement supplies at food pantries in Niagara and Orleans Counties. Bring those donations to the location above where Cub Scouts and Scouts BSA members will greet you and accept your donations!
