Additionally, there was a joint Niagara-Erie County Assessors meeting this past week that had a seminar about solar farms along with warehouse style battery storage of electric power that is fed back to the grid at demand peaks with an associated increase in price. I don't see this as working option in WNY due to the Niagara Power Project Reservoir which is a huge "storage device" for peak demand use.
