

At the regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Pendleton, Niagara County, New York, held in the Board Room at the Town of Pendleton Town Hall, 6570 Campbell Boulevard, Lockport, New York, 14094 at 7:00 p.m. on April 12, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Town of Pendleton owns and maintains a Public Works Facility located at 6640 Campbell Boulevard, and

WHEREAS, the Town of Pendleton has received a grant funding award for construction of a salt storage building to be located adjacent to the Public Works Facility as well as installation of a stand-by generator system for the Public Works Facility, and

WHEREAS, costs associated with planning, design, installation, and construction of the salt storage building and stand-by generator is estimated to exceed the grant award amount.
