Status of mushroom fruiting – burlap had disintegrated, but logs hadn't dried-out. However, no fruiting bodies have been observed. May attempt to water with hose/immerse section of plug spawn-subjected logs into water to trigger fruiting.  
Seed collection for air prune boxes – anecdotal discussion of lack of walnuts, acorns, or other seeds that were going to be used for air prune boxes. Members will continue to scour local sources, but may need to opt to alternative for planned plant giveaway in the spring.
