 - 1. JG notes of Olmstead Park: Front Park off Porter Ave near 190
 - a. Central open field with avenue and grove-style tree plots surrounding walking path with memorials periodically throughout
 - b. Playground surrounded by shrubs and trees that provide shelter, windbreak, and noise-reduction
 - 2. Landscape planning for new Town Park and Community Center
 - a. Continue westward windbreak south of playgrounds, north of Baseball
 Field #7 to help establish different zones.
 - b. Consider establishing avenue-style plantings to serve future walking path
 - c. Link with parks/grounds people from Highway department to combine input and ideas?
 - d. Footpaths to provide greater attention to link to bocce court, ice rink, and other features of town park.
 - e. Any shade trees near splash pad would need to selected to retain leaves, and limit seed drop to avoid any possible slipping.
